

Notice of Emergency Rule WSR #21-02-094

The Washington State Liquor and Cannabis Board (Board) has extended an emergency rule to enforce the requirements of WAC 314-55-1065 prohibiting the use of vitamin E acetate in vapor products, within the context of chapter 69.50 RCW. This emergency rule continues to allow the Board to take disciplinary action against any marijuana retailer licensed under WAC 314-55-079 that fails to comply with the provisions of WAC 314-55-1065 under the authority of chapter 69.50 RCW.

Consistent with RCW 34.05.350, any agency may find that the immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the public interest.

An emergency rule adopted under RCW 34.05.350 takes effect upon filing with the code reviser, unless a later date is specified in the order of adoption, and may not remain in effect for longer than one hundred twenty days after filing.

Consistent with RCW 34.05.350(3), within seven days after the rule is adopted, any person may petition the governor requesting the immediate repeal of a rule adopted on an emergency basis by any department listed in RCW $\underline{43.17.010}$. Within seven days after submission of the petition, the governor shall either deny the petition in writing, stating his or her reasons for the denial, or order the immediate repeal of the rule.
