Drawing on different textures

- At first mark making is about the sensory experience and the cause and effect rather than conveying a message or representing a picture.
- Why not explore mark making on different surfaces rather than just paper?
- Drawing on sandpaper is a fun sensory experience.
- You can even transfer the drawing to a piece of material! Once your child's drawing on sandpaper is complete lay it picture side down on some fabric (such as a white t-shirt) Iron on top slowly. Carefully peel off the sandpaper to reveal your drawing! (Take care transferred crayon may stain other materials such as sofas when warm!)
