Highlights

Debriefing on the EU-UK Trade and Cooperation Agreement



Staff from the European Commission's Task Force for Relations with the United Kingdom will debrief AGRI Members on the EU-UK Trade and Cooperation Agreement concluded last December. While this outcome is a relief for EU agriculture and agrifood, since the sector would have suffered a lot from both partners trading under the rules of the World Trade Organization, there are still some questions left. This applies, for example, to the protection of geographical indications and designations of origin, and the compliance with EU rules and standards to access the Single Market. The discussion with the UKTF should clarify these matters in the context of AGRI preparing its Opinion as part of the EP consent procedure.
