Subject: Diploma Seals

Each year, Indiana accredited high schools are asked to submit the total number of students who are expected to graduate with a Core 40, Core 40 with Academic Honors, Core 40 with Technical Honors, or General diploma types. The Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) uses this information to provide diploma seals to schools.

Ordering Diploma Materials for the 2021-2022 School Year

• Online Order Form

- Submit your school's number of graduates online <u>HERE</u> by **Friday, March 18**.
- Schools must enter the total number of students expected to be eligible for each diploma type:
 - General
 - Core 40 (only) Students who do not qualify for an Honors diploma
 - Core 40 with Academic Honors
 - Core 40 with Technical Honors
- Estimates for each diploma type should be based on the *greatest possible* number of eligible recipients. **Reshipments will not be made if the order is incorrect.**
- Please print and save a copy of your completed online order form (email) as your confirmation.

• Diploma Seals

- General, Core 40, Core 40 with Academic Honors, and Core 40 with Technical Honors seals will be sent to Indiana accredited high schools (who use the order form mentioned above) by the first week of May. Please note that if you misplace your seals, we will not resend orders, and we will not be able to accept orders after the seals have been printed.
- Schools preferring to print seals directly onto diplomas may do so using the
 electronic version of the seals (available in JPEG or PDF), posted to IDOE's
 secure site here (see information below regarding access to this site). Schools
 interested in this option should check with local diploma printer service to
 determine if this is an option.
