




The **Walk of the Week** is at <u>Oakwoods Nature Area</u>. Reach out to <u>GIVE365</u> for <u>Visit Every Park</u> information or to track your walks and earn prizes. Oakwoods Nature Area is 55-acre park located in the far northeast corner of Ann Arbor. The park is tucked between residential neighborhoods and is a quick walk to several other city parks including Sugarbush Park and Arbor Hills Nature Area. It is an undeveloped park with natural, unpaved trails sprawling throughout. Oakwoods is home to an oak-hickory forest, several ponds and a surrounding wetland that make it a beautiful spot for a hike in any season. You will likely catch a glimpse of our local flora and fauna including a variety of bird species and several frog types in the spring!
