This week it is...cups

Saturday – word maker

- This is an activity for older Early Years children who will have started to learn their letter sounds.
- You will need four paper cups cut into different lengths. See the photograph.
- Each cup will have letters written on them. When you turn each cup you can line up the letters to make different words.
- Write these on each cup. Cup 1 draw an arrow.
 Cup 2 s,p,g,d,m,r. Cup 3- the vowels a,e,i,o,u. Cup 4- t,p,ck.
- Line up letters opposite the arrow to create words. This is the word you are making.
- See how many words you can make. You could write these down.
- You could take it in turns to say a word for the other person to spell.
