## **Secure Your 2021-2022 Campus ASVAB Testing Dates**

The ASVAB Career Exploration Program (CEP) program managers are currently scheduling schools for testing in the 2021-2022 school year. The sooner you submit your request, the more likely you are to get your preferred ASVAB test date. One of the most popular dates is in conjunction with PSAT testing. This year the PSAT date is October 13<sup>th</sup>, 2021. However, with a limited amount of CEP personnel and resources, this date fills up quickly for ASVAB testing. Due to the availability of students or facility sizes, schools may test more than once per year. Contact your local CEP program manager regarding any concerns or obstacles and they will work to accommodate your unique situation.

The CEP is dedicated observing your school's visitor protocols while helping students, educators and families continue planning for post-secondary success, as well as helping district compliance with SB 1843 requirements. If your school has protocols in place that limits or prevents outside personnel from entering your campus, the CEP team has two primary alternatives for both administering the ASVAB test and the follow-up Career Seminar.

- **ASVAB Test**: The CEP representative can come to your campus to administer the ASVAB. Alternatively, the Single Site Test (SST) program allows test materials to be shipped to your school for your staff to administer the ASVAB.
- Career Seminar: After the ASVAB has been scored, students are encouraged to attend a
  results interpretation and career exploration seminar. The CEP representative can come
  to your campus and lead the seminar. Alternatively, the seminar can be conducted
  virtually.

For the first time ever, the ASVAB CEP now offers a post-test virtual Career Seminar option. Districts that select this option are encouraged to invite a campus representative to present the session to students using the district's virtual meeting platform of choice. Alternatively, the CEP team is equipped to host the session via Microsoft Teams. Any student who took the ASVAB in the last two years, and their parents or guardians, are welcome to participate in the Career Seminar. As with the in-person Career Seminar, virtual seminar participants will receive an ASVAB score explanation, complete an interest inventory, and explore potentially satisfying career fields.
