## What can I do this week?



**This week it is...Christmas**

### Tuesday – card making

- Giving Christmas cards to family and friends is a good way for children to learn about relationships and giving.
- Children making a card for themselves will help them to feel good about themselves.
- Your child will enjoy exploring the materials and choosing which to use to make their own special card.

You could:

- Help your child to cut out paper triangles and circles. They may decorate the triangle to make a tree card or the circles to make a bauble. Encourage your child to explore the materials. They may choose to use pens, paints and shiny paper to decorate the shapes.
- Take a photograph of your child playing and use that as a Christmas card.
- Take a photograph of something that your child has created, and you cannot attach to a card, such as a dough Christmas tree or the pattern they have made using Christmas decorations. You could put that onto a card for friends and family.
