Summary of Proposed Changes:

- Moves service from 146th Ave SE and SE Allen Rd to SE 36th St, 150th Ave SE, 148th Ave SE, Highland Dr, and Somerset Blvd SE
- New Route 203 on Newport Way provides an alternative for Allen Rd riders.

Replaces Route 246 service in Somerset

How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1?

 More transfer opportunities so riders can travel to different local and regional destinations

^{*}Frequent-The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during off-peak periods.

^{*}Local - All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.

*Peak-only – The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
