Delegated Act on establishments and traceability of kept terrestrial animals*

- Supplements Part IV of Regulation (EU) 2016/429 ("Animal Health Law" AHL):
 - 1. Registration of transporters, approval of establishments, record keeping and registers
 - 2. Traceability of certain kept terrestrial animals
 - 3. Transitional measures to protect the acquired rights resulting from pre-existing Union acts

*Commission Delegated Regulation supplementing Regulation (EU) 2016/429 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards rules for establishments keeping terrestrial animal and hatcheries, and the traceability of certain kept terrestrial animals and hatching eggs (C(2019)4625_final



Supplementing rules concerning registration

- AHL sets out an obligation to register
 - Establishments keeping terrestrial animals
 - Transporters of kept ungulates



- This delegated act sets the following transporters subject to registration:
 - Poultry
 - Dogs, cats and ferrets

Approval of establishments



Establishments subject to approval:

Hatcheries	 Animal shelters for dogs, cats and ferrets
Breeding poultry	• Control posts
Confined establishments	 Environmentally isolated bumble bee production
	 Quarantine for kept terrestrial animals



Approval of establishments

- Requirements for granting approval concerning, where appropriate:
 - Quarantine, isolation and biosecurity measures
 - Surveillance of diseases
 - Facilities and equipment
 - Personnel on the establishment
 - CA's supervision



Additional record-keeping obligations of operators

General record-keeping obligations:	Additional record-keeping obligations:

Operators of hatcheries: Article 103(1) of AHL	✓ Assessing the animal health status✓ Traceability
Transporters: Article 104(1) of AHL	
Operators conducting assembly operations: Article 105(1)	



Registers to be kept by Competent Authority

Register of establishments keeping terrestrial animals

Register of transporters

Register of operators conducting assembly operations for kept ungulates and poultry independently of an establishments

Register of approved establishments

Information provided by the operator to CA for registration or approval is included in the register

Register available to the COM and other MS CA's



Traceability

- Main elements:
 - Register of establishments
 - Means and methods of identification
 - Identification document or movement document (ovine and caprine, and porcine)
 - Computer database
- Rules for different animal species
 - "traditional": bovine, ovine, caprine, equidae, dogs, etc.
 - new: cervidae, camelidae
- Exemptions and special provisions

 Exemptions: bovines kept for cultural, scientific, historical or sporting (or hobby) purposes- permitted by MS








Ovine and caprine

- Exemptions and special rules:
 - within MS:





 animals kept in zoos or for cultural, scientific or hobby purposes- <u>permitted by</u>
 MS



OR



- MS with low population within its territory:
 - ✓ Ovine+caprine <600 000</p>
 - ✓ Caprine <160 000</p>

For slaughter < 12 months (through assembly or fattening)


Derogation:

 porcine kept for cultural or scientific (or hobby) purposespermitted by MS




Dogs and cats
