#### **Neighborhoods Served:**

 Downtown Bellevue, Northwest Bellevue, University of Washington, U-District

#### **Summary of Proposed Changes:**

 Replaces Route 271 service between University of Washington and downtown Bellevue, using the same path, except service between Bellevue Way NE and NE 8<sup>th</sup> St and SR-520 will move to Bellevue Way NE from NE 8<sup>th</sup> St to SR-520

## Why is this change being proposed?

- To better serve Bellevue Way NE
- To create transfer connections at the Yarrow Point and Evergreen Point Freeway Stations

## How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1?

• Make transfers easier with frequent and accessible service, with early and late trips that provide transfers to/from Link

- More transfer opportunities so riders can travel to different local and regional destinations
- Speed and reliability, with more direct paths on faster routes where possible

\* Frequent - The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during off-peak periods.

\*Local – All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.

\* Peak-only – The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
