

#### **Neighborhoods Served:**

Redmond, Overlake, South Kirkland, Seattle, South Lake Union **Summary of Proposed Changes:** 

- Restore Route 544, currently suspended due to pandemic
- Increase service levels up to 10 minutes during peak periods
- Restoration will be timed with the opening of the Downtown Redmond Link Extension in 2024

#### Why is this change being proposed?

• To provide, faster, more direct connections to the 2 Line, Kirkland and South Lake Union

# How does this respond to feedback Sound Transit received in Phase 1?

• More transfer opportunities so riders can travel to different local and regional destinations

\* Frequent - The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during offpeak periods.

\* Local – All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.

\* Peak-only – The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
