# How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1?

• It provides increased frequency during traditional peak commute hours (5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m.)

<sup>\*</sup>Frequent-The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during off-peak periods.

- \*Local All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.

  \*Peak-only The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
