RE: RESOURCES FOR RESPONDING TO COVID-19 IN THE WORKPLACE

This letter provides novel coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) resources for employers and community sectors. Currently, more community outbreaks have been reported since mid-June, as businesses began to reopen. As an employer, it is important that you are prepared to ensure the safety of your staff, customers, and the community should an outbreak occur at your facility.

As such, the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) Occupational Health Branch released guidance on June 16, 2020 that includes a checklist to be used by employers experiencing a COVID-19 outbreak in their workplace. Employers should be proactive and keep in mind that identification of even a single positive case among employees may quickly develop into an outbreak.

In addition to the CDPH checklist, the County encourages your sector to review the resources below. These resources will be helpful in the future and as you develop protocols for managing and preventing an outbreak.
