Poultry meat: the most produced meat in the world




Poultry: Number one meat in the world

120 millions tons

Compared to:

- 119 Mt of pork meat
- 70 Mt of beef meat
- 15 Mt of sheep meat




Poultry: highest growth of all meats

- + 3,4 % average annual growth since begining of 2000's
- + 1,6 % for pork meat
- +1,5 % for sheep meat
- +1 % for beef meat



Poultry imports in EU






Brazil | 1st exporter to EU during the 1st semester of 2019










MERCOSUR | 180 000 additionnal tons!



Cost of legislation are 5 eurocents per kg Live Weight Share in total costs is 6.1% Difference between countries










Creation of huge Brazilian champions

→ Giant export oriented companies





50 to 80 000 tons of exports from Brazil coming outside TRQs

→ Giant export oriented companies could take advantage of the TRQs to displace additionnal volume



The fraud scandal: is brazil a fair player in global meat trade?



Operation Weak Flesh:

- BRF and JBS were accused of having paid Brazilian inspectors to look the other way / allow
 - Rotten meat to be sold
 - Dates of expiration to be altered
 - Disguised meat of poor quality
- Without police operation: contaminated meat would have reached EU
- Highlight serious issue with controls of imported meat



The fraud scandal: is brazil a fair player in global meat trade?



- EU audit in BR slaughterhouses May 2017:
 Critical deficiencies highlighted in Brazilian production
- Reinforced checks at the EU border led to:
 - A LOT of Brazilian meat consignments rejected due to salmonella contamination in poultry meat (RASSF)
 - Highest European recalls in 15 years down to Brazilian Poultry
- Massive decrease of BR imports of poultry meat in the EU in 2017 and 2018



Result of the Mercosur negotiations on poultry meat are incomprehensible



- COM intended to offer 90.000 additional T to Mercosur but in the very last minute the offer was raised to 180.000 T
- Consequences: Brazilians will be able to export more out of quota quantities and will become price setters of the filet market in the EU
- Hard to understand that BR gets this big reward of 180.000 T after fraud...






But Mercosur is not everything...it's just one more ball at the foot of the EU poultry sector...

Average volumes on 2013-2018








Impact of imports on the french broilers production



Weight of imports in the french consumption










Growth of the out-of-home catering and processed foods consumption

AND study, 2016, Imports flow analysis of poultry in France

- ➤ 65 % of out-of-home needs in chicken meat is imported
- > 73 % of processed food from chicken meat produced by industry is imported
