## 3. European Parliamentary Week (EPW) (MK/KS)

This year's European Parliamentary Week, comprised of the European Semester meeting with national Parliaments and the Conference under Article 13 of the Treaty on Stability, Coordination and Governance in the EMU (Fiscal Compact) will take place on 3 – 4 February 2015. The preliminary draft programmes of both events can be found annexed to these notes.

As part of the European Semester event, the EMPL, ECON and BUDG committees will organize parallel Interparliamentary Committee Meetings (ICM), which will take place on 3 February at 11h15 – 13h30. The draft agenda of the 2014 ICM can be found in the annexes.

#### The Coordinators

- Took note of the draft programme of the European Parliamentary Week to be held on 3-4 February 2015 in Brussels
- Decided that in the view of EMPL's previous work on the EU2020 Strategy and on the social dimension of the EMU it should be requested that the 'European Parliamentary Week' session on 'The review of the EU2020 strategy and priorities for the 2015 European Semester Cycle' should be co-chaired by the Chairs of EMPL and ECON
- Decided that the following two topics should be put on the agenda of the EMPL interparliamentary committee meeting:
  - Employment and social indicators' scoreboard in the Macroeconomic Imbalances Procedure (MIP), taking account of youth unemployment
  - o Impact of the Commission's Investment Plan (including the objectives of the European Fund for Strategic Investment and the youth employment targets) on job creation

4. UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (CRPD) (MM)

#### Decision:

#### The Coordinators

- Agreed to take the final decision on the EMPL representative in the 'EU Framework for promoting, protecting and monitoring the CRPD' at their next meeting.
- 5. Joint EMPL CULT Hearing proposals of experts (CO)

- Took note of the agreement with the CULT committee that EMPL and CULT would nominate two experts each and considered nevertheless that three experts should be invited by the EMPL Committee so as to enable also the smaller groups to nominate one expert
- Invited the political groups to submit CVs for each of their candidates
- Agreed to take the final decision on the two experts to be appointed by the EMPL committee at their next meeting.
- 6. Invitation to chairs of EMCO and SPC (KS)

The Coordinators decided to invite the Chairs of the EMCO and of the SPC to the EMPL meeting taking place on 21-22 January.

- agreed that the matter could not be addressed by the committee coordinators at such short notice.

<u>Decision:</u> The Coordinators invited the Greens/EFA Group to submit the title of their fresh proposal for an own-initiative report replacing the withdrawn request on the TTIP.

- mandated the Chair to write to Commissioners Thyssen and Bulc expressing concerns about recent developments in the abuse of flags of convenience in aviation, if possible together with the Chair of TRAN,
- decided to hold an exchange of views about this issue during a future EMPL meeting, inviting the social partners, researchers and the Commission.
