Subject: Reading Plan Guidance and Dyslexia Reporting

Pursuant to <u>511 Indiana Administrative Code (IAC) 6.2-3.1</u>, all public schools and accredited non-public schools with students enrolled in kindergarten through grade three are required to submit an annual reading plan to the Indiana Department of Education (IDOE). Charter schools are not required to submit a reading plan to IDOE, but must submit the reading plan to their charter sponsor. The submission window is Friday, April 14, through Friday, June 30 for the 2023-2024 school year.

The reading plan requires information regarding:

- 1. The school literacy leadership team;
- 2. Curriculum or programming for core reading instruction;
- 3. Achievement goals and assessments for each grade level;
- 4. Interventions:
- 5. Description of professional development; and
- 6. A monitoring plan for effectiveness of intervention.

In addition to the reading plan, <u>Indiana Code (IC) 20-35.5</u> requires all public and charter schools to report dyslexia screening data from the current 2022-2023 school year. Accredited non-public schools are not required to submit data, but have the option to report.

All forms must be submitted by Friday, June 30, 2023.
