The Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) invites stakeholders to apply for committees involving the review of curriculum materials to support future-focused Indiana Academic Standards for the areas of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math, Reading aligned to the science of reading (SoR), and the Indiana Early Learning Standards. Participants will meet virtually three times to discuss the process, but will complete curriculum reviews asynchronously.
