The **Digital Fast Track** provides learners with real experience and the 'Introduction to Digital Technology' qualification. Learners will spend the first seven weeks being upskilled by our tutors, learning valuable digital and employability skills.

Learners will then spend a minimum of 3 weeks with employers on a work experience placement to utilise their skills and knowledge.

The course consists of the following -**Technical & Employability Units (Weeks 1-7)**

- Digital Presence, Awareness and Safety; Principles of Marketing; Digital Technology in the Workplace. Behaviours and Standards at Work.
- Key Elements of Digital Marketing; How to Set Up an IT Network. Producing a CV; Team Working.
- Introduction to Design and Development of Software; Introduction to Installing Computer Software. Succeeding at Interview: Identifying Suitable Opportunities.

Work Placement (Weeks 7+)

During the work experience placement, learners will focus on building an implementing real projects. There are a wide range of marketing and IT related projects that can be carried out to the benefit of the company, including creating social media profiles, planning and implementing a marketing campaign, and performing an IT Security audit. As part of this program, we also encourage learners to contribute with day-to-day activities to help with the running of the business.

- Unemployed or working less than 16 hours
- Not in Education
- Lived in the UK for the last 3 years
- Eligible for benefits or public funds
