STAR+PLUS HCBS IL Releases

Background:

 The Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) stopped interest list (IL) releases of the STAR+PLUS Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) program in April 2020.

Resuming STAR+PLUS HCBS IL Release Activity:

- HHSC will resume STAR+PLUS HCBS program IL releases in February 2021.
- Approximately 3,000 individuals will be included in the STAR+PLUS HCBS program February 2021 IL release.
- The IL release will be throughout the state of Texas.





Services

STAR+PLUS HCBS IL Releases

Individuals released should expect the following:

- The Texas contracted enrollment broker, Maximus, will begin contacting individuals released from the STAR+PLUS HCBS program IL in February 2021 to:
 - Provide an overview of the STAR+PLUS HCBS program benefits and services,
 - Confirm contact and address information, and
 - Verify their interest in pursuing the STAR+PLUS HCBS program.



STAR+PLUS HCBS IL Releases

Individuals released should expect the following:

- A STAR+PLUS HCBS program enrollment packet will be mailed to individuals who express a desire to pursue the program in March 2021.
 - Each individual will have 30 days to complete and return the enrollment packet to begin the eligibility and enrollment process.
