Underlines the ***role that*** ***environmentally safe*** Carbon Capture Storage and Utilisation (CCS/U) ***can play in*** reaching the European Green Deal objectives; supports an integrated policy context to stimulate the uptake of environmentally safe CCS/U applications that deliver a net reduction in greenhouse gas emissions ***to make heavy industry climate neutral where no direct emission reduction options are available^{1a};*** ***reaffirms, however, that the EU net-zero strategy should prioritise direct emission reductions and actions maintaining and enhancing the EU's natural sinks and reservoirs^{2a};***
